



PENTECOST TO TRUMPET MINISTRIES

The preaching of the gospel started at Pentecost and end at the last trumpet.

Statement of Faith.

All members subscribe to the statement of faith.

1. The Bible, consisting of the Old and New Testaments in their original writing, is the fully inspired and only infallible Word of God.

We accept it as the supreme and final authority for doctrine, faith and life.

2. There is one God, self-revealed in three persons and manifestations: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

3. The deity of the Lord Jesus Christ, His virgin birth, His sinless life, His miracles, His vicarious and atoning death through His shed blood, His bodily resurrection, His ascension to the right hand of God the Father, His personal future return in power and glory.

4. Man was created good, upright and in the image of God, but man, by the voluntary transgression of Adam and Eve, fell into sin, losing goodness and fellowship of God, and his only hope of redemption is in Jesus Christ the Son of God.

5. The only means of being cleansed from sin is through repentance toward God and faith in the finished work of the Lord Jesus Christ. Man is justified by grace alone and this through faith.

6. They who receive Jesus Christ as Lord and Saviour by repentance and faith in Jesus Christ are born again by the Holy Spirit and become children and heirs of God.

The New Birth is absolutely essential for personal salvation and eternal life. John 3.

7. We believe the Lord Jesus appointed two ordinances;

7.1. believer's baptism by immersion in water as a public witness and confession of faith and identification with Christ declaring that we have died with Jesus and have also been raised with Him to walk with Him in newness of life, - *We reject the sprinkling of babies as void of any Scriptural basis.*

7.2. and the Lord's Supper is the partaking of the emblems, the bread and the fruit of the vine, a memorial of His suffering and death and a prophesy of His second coming by all believers "until He come".

8. We believe in the baptism of the Holy Spirit with the speaking in unknown tongues as the Spirit of God gives them utterance and the operation of the gifts of the Holy Spirit for the edification of the body of Christ.

9. We believe in the sanctifying power of the Holy Spirit by whose indwelling the Christian is enabled to live a life of righteousness and true holiness.
10. We believe that the Holy Spirit convicts of sin, righteousness and judgement, to bring to repentance.(John 16) We reject the believe that the devil convicts of sin to make believers feel bad.
11. The Church is the body of Christ, the habitation of God through the Spirit, with divine appointment for the fulfilment of her great commission. Each Christian believer who is redeemed by Jesus Christ and regenerated by the Holy Spirit is part of the body.
12. We believe that it is Scripturally and historically sound that believers congregate, whether in dedicated church buildings, houses or other *sanctified* places God gives them to gather in.
13. The new birth and a personal confession of Christ are essentials for membership of the local church, and that the church gathering is for believers, not unbelievers. We also believe that every believer is responsible to go out evangelize, and then bring new believers who repents, to the church as new family in Christ, according to Math 28.
14. We believe in the second coming of Jesus Christ as He promised in Scripture.
15. We believe in the resurrection of the saved and the lost, the one to everlasting life and the other to everlasting damnation.
16. We believe the existence of a real heaven and a real hell as described by the Bible.
17. We believe holiness is as essential as the Bible says it is.
18. We believe that faithful regular church activity is very important for all believers, and that clear Biblical church standards and discipline is important.
19. We believe that marriage is between one man and one woman, and we do not approve, accept, endorse or permit same-sex marriage.
20. We expect from our leadership to refrain from drinking alcohol, smoking and sexual relations outside of marriage.
